Cookies on our sites

This policy explains what cookies are, how Involving Communities Ltd uses cookies, and how you can prevent us from setting them on your device.

Information about the use of cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. Generally speaking, this helps website owners to provide you with a good experience when you browse their website and also allows them to improve their sites. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree.

Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Different types of cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are required for the operation of a website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of a website, use a shopping cart or to make use of e-billing services.

Involving Communities Ltd doesn't have secure areas on the websites, it doesn't operate a shopping cart and as we don't sell anything from the website, we have no cause to bill anyone.

Analytical/performance cookies

They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Involving Communities Ltd does use this type of cookie. We are able to see when the site is most used, which pages are accessed and how long a user stays on any particular page. We can see which country users are from and which operating system they use to access our site.

We are interested in numbers of visitors and which day and at what time users make their visits. We are also interested in how they find or are referred to our site, this helps us with search engine optimisation (SEO) and where to invest time in social media platforms.

Functionality cookies

These are used to recognise you when you return to a website. This enables website owners to personalise their content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Involving Communities Ltd never asks your name, nor are your preferences requested or retained.

Targeting cookies

These cookies record your visit to a website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Involving Communities Ltd does not advertise on any of its sites

Some pages on the Involving Communities Ltd site carry buttons linked to Facebook, Twitter, Google plus, Pinterest and other social media sites. These sites may set cookies on your computer when you visit our pages carrying those buttons. Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies which are explained above.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.
